QUESTION:

In the city of Chicago, the installation of a “Fireman’s Dump” is required. The dump is connected to the low side of the refrigeration system and, in case of an emergency, it allows the ammonia charge to be mixed with water by the fire department and dumped into the sewer.

Is the piping after the ammonia/water mixer considered part of the refrigeration system?
