



INTERPRETATION: IIAR SRC 2000-2

SUBJECT: IIAR 2-1999

DATE ISSUED: MARCH 31, 2000

QUESTION:

Does IIAR 2-1999 forbid the use of duplicate nameplates on pressure vessels applied in ammonia refrigeration service?

REPLY:

No. Provided that the vessel bears a nameplate in accordance with 5.10.3 and that the duplicate nameplate complies with the governing edition of Section VIII, Division I, ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code (8.6), as required by 5.10.1.2. Particular attention should be paid to Paragraph UG-119 (f), specifying the requirements for duplicate nameplate stamping and mounting, and Paragraph UG-119 (d), specifying the manufacturer's obligations to ensure a proper match of duplicate to original.

COMMITTEE ACTION:

Paragraph 5.10.3 will be modified in the next revision of the Standard to provide additional guidelines for duplicate nameplates.
